

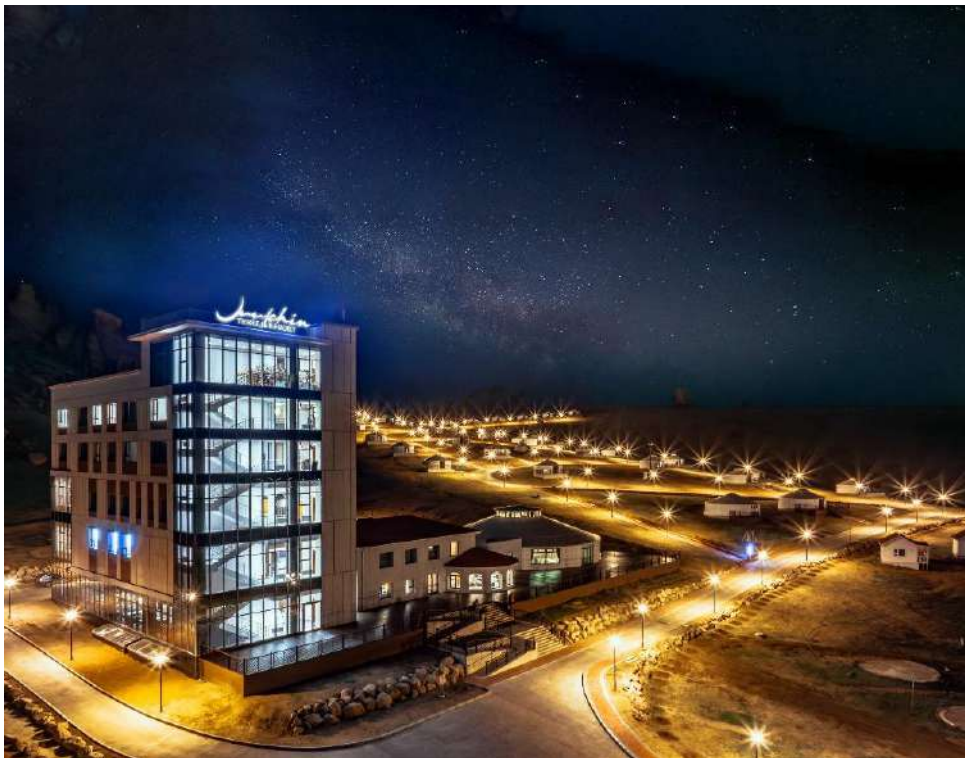

Day Trip Option 1:

Chinggis Khaan Equestrian Statue & Terelj National Park



At 08:00 the Juulchin team picks you up from your hotel and we head east to the iconic Chinggis Khaan Equestrian Statue, the world's largest equestrian statue standing 40 meters high and recognized by Guinness World Records, where we take time to explore the museum and even walk up to the horse's head for a panoramic view of the surrounding steppe. We then continue our drive to Terelj National Park, one of Mongolia's most scenic destinations known for its dramatic granite rock formations, lush valleys, and peaceful alpine landscapes. By lunchtime, we arrive at Juulchin Terelj Resort and enjoy a relaxed meal before heading out to explore the area, visiting the famous Turtle Rock, the symbol of Terelj, and the Aryapala Meditation Temple nestled in the mountains, offering breathtaking panoramic views. Later, we visit a local nomadic family where we learn about their traditional lifestyle and daily routines, followed by a 45-minute horse riding experience accompanied by a horseman, with full safety instructions provided by your guide. In the evening, we return to Juulchin Terelj Resort for dinner before driving back to Ulaanbaatar, where we drop you off at your hotel and this concludes our service.

Day Trip Option 2: Hustai National National Park



At 09:00, the Juulchin team picks you up from your hotel and we head west to Hustai National Park, a protected area renowned for the successful reintroduction of the world's last remaining wild horse, the Przewalski's horse (Takhi), as well as its rich steppe ecosystem. Upon arrival, we visit the park's information centre to learn about the conservation efforts, history of the Takhi, and the unique wildlife and landscapes of the region. We then enjoy lunch at the camp's restaurant where a buffet set is served. In the afternoon, we set out on a safari-style drive through the park to spot the wild horses in their natural habitat, and along the way we may also encounter other wildlife such as deer, marmots, and various bird species. After the excursion, we drive back to the city, where we drop you off at your hotel and this concludes our service.

Day Trip Option 3: Mongol Nomadic Show



At 08:00, the Juulchin team picks you up from your hotel and we head to the Mongol Nomadic Ger Camp, located in the beautiful countryside just outside Ulaanbaatar. Upon arrival, we enjoy the iconic “Mongol Nomadic Show,” a lively cultural performance that brings Mongolia’s rich nomadic heritage to life, featuring traditional horsemanship, archery, yak and camel riding demonstrations, as well as folk music, throat singing, and vibrant costumes representing different ethnic groups. Afterwards, we have lunch at the ger camp where a traditional Mongolian meal is served, including hard-boiled mutton accompanied by simple vegetable side dishes. In the afternoon, we drive back to the city, where we drop you off at your hotel and this concludes our service.

Day Trip Option 4: City Tour Ulaanbaatar



After breakfast, the Juulchin team picks you up and we begin our city tour with a visit to Sukhbaatar Square, the central plaza of Ulaanbaatar surrounded by key landmark. From there in walking distance, we visit the Chinggis Khaan National Museum, where we explore Mongol Empire's rich history, with the highlight being the impressive golden statue of the Great Khaan at the top floor. We then enjoy lunch at a restaurant in the city centre before heading to Gandan Monastery, the largest and most important Buddhist monastery in Mongolia, where we experience the peaceful atmosphere, observe monks in prayer, and visit the towering Migjid Janraisig, a symbol of compassion. After the visit, we drop you off at your hotel and this concludes our service.

4-Day Tour Gobi Desert Overland




Day 1 | Overland journey to Gobi Desert

We pick you up from your hotel at 08:00 and begin our journey toward the Gobi Desert, setting off on a scenic but long drive through Mongolia's vast steppe landscapes. Please note that today involves a considerable distance, so we take our time with a comfortable pace and planned stops along the way. Around midday, we stop in Mandalgobi town to enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before continuing deeper into the Gobi region, where the scenery gradually transforms into more arid and dramatic terrain. We arrive at the ger camp by dinner time, where we settle in and enjoy a warm meal, followed by an overnight stay in the ger camp.

Day 2 | Khongor Sand Dunes




Today we head to the magnificent Khongor Sand Dunes, the largest and most spectacular sand dunes in Mongolia, stretching for over 180 kilometers and rising up to 300 meters in places, often referred to as the “Singing Dunes” due to the humming sound created by shifting sands in the wind. Upon arrival, we check in to our ger camp and enjoy lunch before heading out to explore the area, trekking up the towering dunes for breathtaking views over the vast Gobi Desert and the lush green Khongor River oasis below. Later in the afternoon, we visit a local nomadic family of camel breeders to learn about their traditional lifestyle, daily routines, and the important role camels play in the Gobi region. After receiving safety instructions from our guide, we enjoy an authentic camel riding

experience across the desert landscape. In the evening, we return to the ger camp for dinner and overnight, surrounded by the peaceful silence of the Gobi.

Day 3 | Yol Valley & Flaming Cliffs



After breakfast, we head to Yol Valley, a deep and narrow gorge located within the Gurvan Saikhan Mountains, known for its dramatic rock walls, shaded trails, and even patches of ice that can remain throughout much of the year despite the desert surroundings. We have lunch at a nearby ger camp before entering the valley, then explore the area on foot by hiking through the canyon, enjoying the cool microclimate and unique landscape; if we are lucky, we may spot wildlife such as ibex, wild mountain sheep, and marmots along the way. Later, we continue to the famous Flaming Cliffs, also known as Bayanzag, renowned for their striking red sandstone formations and as the site where the world's first dinosaur eggs were discovered. In the evening, we take in the breathtaking sunset when the cliffs glow in vivid shades of red and orange, creating a truly unforgettable scene, before driving to the ger camp and arriving by dinner time.

Day 4 | Back to Ulaanbaatar

We arrive in Ulaanbaatar by dinner time, and after dinner we drop you off at your hotel, marking the end of our services.
